

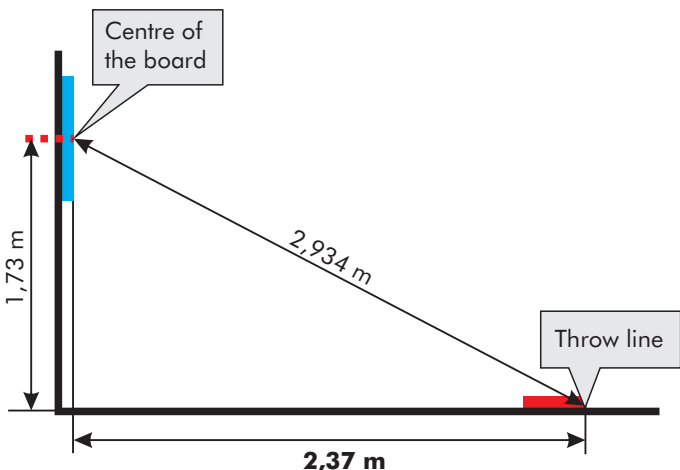

Dartboard double sided
10 darts (5 red and 5 yellow)
2 spare shafts
2 spare flights



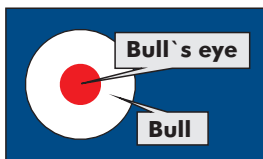
Installation of the Dartboard

The Dartboard is fixed against a wall, the centre of the board being 1.73 m above floor. The horizontal distance from the throw line to the board is 2,37 m. The diagonal distance from the throw line to the centre of the board is 2.934 m.



Rules of the game

Each player receives 5 darts (red or yellow).



The first player starts by throwing each of his 5 darts against the board. Darts hitting one of the nine red/white target zones (white zone = Bull's eye / red zone = Bull) remain on the board, while the other darts have to be retracted by the player. After that it's to the opponent to play.

A target zone can not be double hit. The second hitting dart needs to be retracted by the player.

After that, the players continue by alternatively throwing the remaining darts until the game ends.

The game ends and the points are attributed as soon as one of the following situations occurs:

1 row white*	1 Point	e.g. fig. ①
5 any white*	1 Point	e.g. fig. ②
5 any red	2 Points	e.g. fig. ③
1 row red	3 Points	e.g. fig. ④
Double row white*	3 Points	e.g. fig. ⑤
Double row 1 white*/ 1 red	4 Points	e.g. fig. ⑥
Double row red	6 Points	e.g. fig. ⑦

* white or white and red mixed

A row can be played horizontally, diagonally or vertically.
In a team play, the partners are playing alternatively.
